<p>Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Fred reported a balance \$2,114.12 being \$800 in surplus compared to the 1988 October balance. He anticipates a credit balance of between \$700 and 800 at the end of the current year.</p>	
<p>News Letter Editor Jim to advise members of a possible fee reduction for 1990-91 in the January edition of the news letter. New members to pay \$10 subscription and \$15 joining fee.</p>
